Introduction

ILC takes care of your personal information and we will process it in accordance with the applicable rules and legislation at all times. Personal data is all the information that to some extent can be attributed to you. When you use our website, we collect and process such information.

We use data about you

We use data about you to improve our service and ensure quality in our services and in our contact with you. We do not collect sensitive information about you. When you are a member or contributor with us, we collect the following general personal information from you: Name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, registration and account number. Registration and account numbers are only collected in the event that you as an individual or you as a foundation, company, association, organization or the like donate funds to the ILC association. Depending on your relationship with us, we collect information about your CPR number if, for example, you want a tax deduction for any contributions, or if we have a reporting obligation.

When you visit our website www.ilcdk.com and other related websites and click around, we collect IP addresses for logging the activity.

Security

We have taken steps to ensure that your information is deleted, published, lost, degraded or comes to the knowledge of unauthorized persons, is misused or otherwise processed in violation of the law.

Purpose

The information is used to identify you as a user, to register your or your donations, and to be able to provide the services you / I have requested. Depending on whether you are a member or contributor to us, or perhaps just a user of our website, we are obliged to process your personal information to such an extent that we can provide you with the services you request and that we can live up to the obligations we have as an association. This applies both when handling your possible contributions - unless you choose to contribute anonymously, as well as when we manage your membership with the ILC Association. We consider it a relationship when you provide your email address and telephone number, for example in connection with signature collections, and we contact you to offer you a membership of the association. If you do not want to be contacted, you can send an email to: contact@ilcdk.com

Administration of members

When creating a membership, you will be created in our member database and allow the ILC Association to contact you by e-mail and telephone in connection with the association's work. You can also choose to sign up for our newsletters, which come by e-mail. You can unsubscribe from the newsletters at any time. We make sure that other recipients of newsletters cannot see your email address. In order to comply with the Accounting Act, we retain your personal information for 5 years from the end of the financial year in which you had to opt out of the ILC Association.

Data minimization

We collect, process and store only the personal data necessary to fulfill our stated purpose.

Data is kept up to date

As our service depends on your data being accurate and up to date, we ask you to inform us of relevant changes to your data. If you are a member of the ILC Association, your data can be corrected via "My Page", which is your entrance to the electronic member database or by sending an email to: contact@ilcdk.com

Disclosure of information

We use a number of third parties for the storage and processing of data, including suppliers of IT solutions. These process information solely on our behalf and may not use it for their own purposes. We do not pass on your personal data without your consent, however, we do not obtain consent if we are legally obliged to pass on personal data as part of reporting to an authority.

Privacy policy in connection with job applications

If you send an application with a CV and other relevant documents to us, the submitted material will be read by the recruitment committee and the relevant manager upon receipt with the aim of being able to answer and assess the content in relation to a specific job or in connection with an unsolicited application.

Application, CV and appendices are shared internally with relevant people in the recruitment process, but are not passed on to others outside the company. Application, CV and appendices are saved until the right candidate is found and the recruitment process is completed.

Thereafter, the documents will be deleted unless otherwise agreed with you. In the case of unsolicited applications, the application, CV and appendices are stored for the period agreed with you and otherwise for 3 months, after which it is deleted.

Use of cookies

When you visit our website, information about you is collected, which is used to adapt and improve the content on the website. If you do not want information to be collected, you should delete your cookies and refrain from further use of the website. A cookie is a small text file that we store on your computer, mobile or similar for the purpose of recognizing it, remembering settings and performing statistics.

How to reject or delete your cookies

You can always reject cookies on your computer by changing the settings in your Internet browser. Where you find the settings depends on which browser you use. However, you should be aware that if you do, there are many features and services that you can not use because these features and services require the website to remember the choices you make. If you delete or block cookies, you may also risk that the website does not work optimally, and that there is content that you can not access.

Insights and complaints

You can always gain insight into what personal information we have about you. You can also object to the use of information at any time. You can also revoke your consent for information about you to be processed. If the information processed about you is incorrect, you have the right to have it corrected or deleted.
